Lashof Violins, located just north of the Washington DC beltway, in Gaithersburg, MD, was opened in 1988 by David Lashof. They carry an extensive line of accessories from cases to strings, as well as bows, chin rests, shoulder rests and many other items. They also carry more than 1,000 of the most requested titles of violin, viola, cello and bass sheet music and books.




David Lashof, began his musical career at an early age and at

age 15, he made his first violin under the tutelage of Willis M. Gault. In 1977, David continued his violin making education at the Chicago School of Violin Making with Master Tschu Ho Lee. Upon graduation, he went to work for Weavers Violin Shop in Maryland as the cello and bass repair specialist. Working closely with William Weaver and Roger Kirkbride, a bow specialist, David continued to refine and hone his repair skills. When Roger Kirkbride retired, David, the senior repairman and only violin maker on staff, completed the more complicated restorations such as neck grafts and sound post patches. To date, David has made more than 160 instruments. Presently his instruments are made on commission basis.

After 35 years in the violin business, David currently acts as a consultant to the managers, Alicia

Coberly and Genevieve Swift. Alicia and Genevieve have been in charge of the day-to-day running of the shop, including instrument restorations. Alicia earned a BA in Music from Immaculata University where she studied both violin and voice. She has been an employee for 10 years, apprenticing as a violin maker for 5 years. Genevieve Swift, has a BA in Sociology and has been apprenticing in violin restoration and making for 4 years with David Lashof.



Repairs of all instruments are performed on site, nothing is sent out. Lashof Violins is the repair facility for several music stores in the DC area and beyond as well as a supplier of new string instruments and the repair facility for Montgomery County Public Schools. All of the staff are trained instrument repair technicians with countless hours behind the bench and have over 75 years of combined experience in the violin business. Frequently Asked Questions or Ask The Expert

Below are some guidelines and tips for using the featured products in this newsletter.

Buffcote[™] Lacquer

Directions: Stir thoroughly before using. Seal with a full wet coat of **Clear WW Lacquer Sealer** (M610-2500) or E-Z Vinyl® Sealer (M610-800) and allow to dry for 30-45 minutes. Sand thoroughly with 220-320 grit stearated sandpaper, and remove dust before topcoat application. Apply full wet coats of Buffcote[™] (M614-3XXX). Second and third coats are optional (total dry film should not exceed 4 mils). If sanding between coats is desired, use 240 or finer grit paper and remove dust before topcoating. If finish is to be rubbed, 3 coats may be necessary. NOTE: Mohawk Buffcote[™] (M614-3XXX) is manufactured at spray viscosity. Mohawk Lacquer Reducer (M650-010) is recommended for equipment clean up.

White Undercoater

Directions: Stir product thoroughly after opening. White Undercoater should be applied in full, wet coats. If two coats are used, sand first White Undercoater coat with 220 grit sandpaper. Enough sanding should take place to remove the equivalent of one primer coat. Scuff sand second coat with 320 grit stearated, taking care to not sand through on edges. Excess White Undercoater may lead to poor adhesion or cold check problems. Remove sanding dust before topcoat application. NOTE: Mohawk White Undercoater is manufactured at spray viscosity. If further reduction is required, Mohawk **Lacquer Reducer** is recommended. Mohawk Clear or opaque lacquers, opaque pre-catalyzed lacquers and opaque conversion varnishes are the recommended topcoats for the White Undercoater. Apply full wet coats and cover thoroughly to insure color control.

Perfect Blend™

When using Perfect Blend[™] clean the surface to be sprayed with Mohawk Wax Wash[™]

Remover M712-190. For best results, can temperature should be 65° - 90°. Shake well before using for at least one minute after ball rattles to ensure sheen uniformity. Point opening of spray button toward object, holding can 12 to 14 inches away from surface to be coated. Press spray button firmly. Use steady, even strokes. Several thin coats give a better finish than one heavy coat. Allow coating to become tacky between coats. Clean spray button immediately by spraying with can turned upside down until no more product comes out.
